### **UP-DATE INFORMATION for WMD EQUIVALENT TRAINING (Type 1 Inspections) [ For Inspection Purposes Only ]**

#### **O.E.S. Hazardous Materials Team Typing Program**

**MEMO:** The following information applies only to TYPE 1 HAZARDOUS MATERIALS TEAM CERTIFICATION AND INSPECTION. This information is provided as a supporting guide and shall be followed and applied as necessary by the Cal/EMA Fire & Rescue Branch haz-mat team typing inspection team regarding the FIRESCOPE Hazardous Materials Company Typing and Minimum Standards. The FOG (ICS 420-1) *Hazardous Materials Company Types, Company Typing, and Minimum Standard* chart (page 13-19, 2004 Edition) document requires that the personnel of a Type 1 Hazardous Materials Company must show certification proof of training, in addition to the HMS 240 hours (CSTI certified) level, of a minimum of 16 additional hours of WMD training. This training must be certifiable through a recognized accredited governmental agency (Sponsor) or a recognized accredited educational institute (Provider). This training shall be the CSTI curricula "Technician Specialist Terrorism" 16 hour course, or equivalent. The following information is a listing of equivalent certifiable WMD type of training that is acceptable at the time of inspection, provided that there is proper training record documentation, proof of completion for each team member by certificate, the curriculum meets or exceeds that as specified, and the Sponsor is an accredited governmental agency, or the Provider is a recognized educational institute.

#### **Acceptable Equivalent WMD Courses for HMS and Type 1 Team Certification**

To satisfy the HMS-WMD Certification for the Fire & Rescue Branch TYPE 1 haz-mat team typing requirement, WMD course must contain basic introductory WMD information, as well as detection techniques and instrument monitoring introduction. Training must also include the requirement of including at least 4 hours of actual hands-on WMD specialty instrument monitoring, sampling, and testing.
