PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The purpose of the Crisis Response Training (CR) Program is to develop and provide comprehensive crisis response training to local Victim/Witness Programs and multi-disciplinary teams for response and recovery readiness efforts. Under the direction of Cal OES, the California Crisis Response Teams (CCRT) will act as a consortium of trained and skilled personnel; local Victim/Witness agencies; and trained professionals responsible for assessing the immediate needs of victims, providing crisis intervention, support services, and training to communities in the aftermath of a traumatic community event.

The desired outcome will be the development of a network of highly trained professionals coordinated through a single system able to respond in a comprehensive and timely manner to the needs of victims of disasters and/or traumatic events to provide crisis response, follow-up consultation, and referrals. All assistance efforts will be provided free of charge with dignity and respect for individual and cultural differences.
