

FAMILY VIOLENCE PREVENTION PROGRAM

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Family Violence Prevention (FV) Program, pursuant to California Penal Code §§13820-13823, expands efforts and builds the capacity of local family violence prevention efforts by funding local prevention staff to implement a prevention program and increase citizen involvement in their service area. This Program is intended for projects which have prevention staff and provide prevention activities but need additional support and staff time to fully implement those strategies.

Projects are required to implement an existing prevention strategy, tailor prevention materials to their specific community, and attend a skills-based training through Cal OES's Statewide Domestic Violence Prevention Resource Center Program. Subrecipients have chosen to implement a school-based Program in order to further prevention efforts in their community.
