The HA Program is a new program, funded by the Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) Victim Assistance Program, to provide funding to California Victim/Witness Assistance Centers who have demonstrated a partnership, collaboration or coordination of services with an Anti-Human Trafficking Task Force within the county and/or service area(s). The Program provides funding to 10 Victim/Witness Assistance Centers to provide additional support, such as, hiring additional staff, identifying additional human trafficking victims, and providing comprehensive services to victims of human trafficking.
