PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Minor Victims of Human Trafficking (HC) Program is a new program authorized by AB 764 (Swanson 2011) to aid in addressing the problem of human trafficking in California. The Program funds community-based organizations to provide comprehensive treatment and referral services to minor victims of human trafficking. Comprehensive services must meet the standards described in California Penal Code §13837.

Funds for the HC Program are supported by the Child Victims of Human Trafficking Fund and are used to support salaries of therapeutic and administrative staff and minimal operating costs to the support the Program.
