**PROGRAM OVERVIEW**

Each year, State Restitution Funds are provided to California's five federally-recognized Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Forces to expand their activities involving the investigation, arrest, and prosecution of individuals using the Internet to exploit children and to increase training opportunities to law enforcement and the public regarding cyber criminals who prey on children and teens.

There are five ICAC task forces funded with these State Restitution Funds: San Diego Police Department, Los Angeles Police Department, San Jose Police Department, Sacramento Sheriff's Department, and Fresno Sheriff's Department.
