PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Law Enforcement Training (PO) Program is supported with federal Services*Training*Officers*Prosecutors (STOP) Violence Against Women Formula Grant Program funds. The STOP Formula Grant Program was authorized in 1994 through Title IV of the Violent Crime Control and Enforcement Act of 1994 and subsequent reauthorizations. The most recent reauthorization is the Violence Against Women Act (VAWA) and Department of Justice Act of 2013.

The Program funds the San Diego Regional Training Center, in collaboration with the California Commission on POST, to:

- Coordinate and facilitate quarterly Law Enforcement Training Advisory Council meetings to solicit recommendations and feedback from stakeholders;
- Update training curriculum;
- Provide training for law enforcement personnel throughout the State in the areas of sexual assault, sexual assault forensic medical exams, domestic violence (including officer-involved domestic violence), domestic violence crisis negotiation, stalking, dating violence, and culturally specific training as it relates to these crimes;
- Provide outreach to law enforcement personnel; and
- Provide scholarships for law enforcement personnel to attend trainings.
