**PROGRAM OVERVIEW**

The Statewide Domestic Violence Prevention Resource Center (PV) Program, pursuant to California Penal Code §§13820-13823, establishes a resource center for the collection, retention, and distribution of educational materials related to domestic violence and/or family violence and its prevention. In addition, the Program provides training and ongoing technical assistance to recipients of the Cal OES Family Violence Prevention Program.

This Program was newly developed for fiscal year 2014/15. Cal OES collaborated with the California Department of Public Health, the California Partnership to End Domestic Violence, and the Domestic Violence Advisory Council to identify current gaps in domestic violence and family violence prevention programs across California.
