PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The goal of the Rape Crisis (RC) Program is to reduce the level of trauma experienced by sexual assault survivors through the provision of comprehensive and supportive services, to improve coordination of multi-disciplinary response systems, and to expand public awareness concerning sexual assault and its impact. With federal funding increasing in some areas and maintaining in others, the 84 Rape Crisis Program grant recipients were able to sustain the same level of service provision as in the previous year. This is due in large part to the commitment of the professionals and volunteers who serve the needs of sexual assault survivors.

This Program, pursuant to California Penal Code §§13836-13837, funds rape crisis centers to provide comprehensive services to sexual assault victims as they deal with the emotional trauma resulting from such an assault and as they progress through the criminal justice system. These services include:

- Crisis intervention/24-hour crisis line services;
- 72-hour follow-up services;
- Accompaniment services (forensic medical exams, law enforcement, district attorneys);
- Advocacy services;
- In-person and group counseling;
- Community education presentations about sexual assault and the centers' services; and
- Participation in local multi-disciplinary Sexual Assault Response Team (SART) efforts;
