**PROGRAM OVERVIEW**

The Teen Dating Violence Prevention (TV) Program is supported with federal Services\*Training\*Officers\*Prosecutors (STOP) Violence Against Women Formula Grant Program funds. The STOP Formula Grant Program was authorized in 1994 through the Violence Against Women Act (VAWA) and was reauthorized in 2000, 2005 and most recently in 2013 and is administered by the Office on Violence Against Women, Office of Justice Programs, U.S. Department of Justice.

The purpose of the TV Program is to expand prevention efforts in California and build the capacity of local prevention efforts by funding local organizations to implement and evaluate comprehensive school-based teen dating violence prevention programs that seek to address school climate change with their service area. A comprehensive, school-based program includes strategies and activities that impact students, school administrators and staff, parents, and communities. Cal OES collaborated with the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) and the California Partnership to End Domestic Violence to develop this program.
