Basic Public Information Officer (G290): Public information consists of the processes, procedures and systems to get the right information, to the right people, at the right time, to make the right decisions. This course is designed for people who work with the media in times of crisis and day-to-day media relations. This training will equip participants with the basic skills needed to function as Public Information Officers (PIOs), such as oral and written communications, understanding and working with the media, and basic tools and techniques needed to perform effectively.

Participants engage in public speaking exercises and media interview sessions. Classroom and breakout sessions are information intensive and are designed to help participants apply principles and techniques taught in the discussions.

Participants will work with representatives from the media and other agencies involved in crisis communications.
