In an effort to be helpful to all agencies pursuing the acquisition of equipment and tools in concert with the requirements and performance criteria in the *FIRESCOPE HAZARDOUS MATERIALS STANDARDIZED EQUIPMENT LIST (SEL)*, the following table has been developed. The information included in this table is to be used only for the purposes of facilitating the local emergency response organization in their investigation of possible sources such as vendors, suppliers, mail order houses, and manufacturers. Sources shown are not to be considered the only possible source, and in many cases there are numerous other possible sources or vendors for the item specified. References to pre-assembled commercial kits, systems, and some specific manufacturers models are to be considered only as a recommended baseline, and is meant to be interpreted only as a suggested source that is known to meet SEL minimum descriptions. Other sources may exist that meet or exceed those as shown, and those shown are not to be considered the only source, only an example source.

It should be remembered that the arena of equipment, tools, electronic devices, and any other support product developed and marketed to the hazardous materials response community is highly competitive and ever-changing. Dated models are continuously being upgraded or discontinued, and new designs and
