<b>1. Orange City Fire Dept</b>	<b>Area Plan Update</b>	<b>\$7,617</b>
Funding for Area Plan update – Area Plan was last updated in 2009. Contractor will be hired to revise the Plan. Updates include: changes to HazMat disclosure program and CERS; pesticide drift protocols; consolidation in the Orange Co HazMat Emergency Response JPA; city, county, state and federal response plans and resources; qualitative commodity flow information; and other conforming changes.		
<b>2. Newport Beach Fire Dept</b>	<b>Area Plan Update</b>	<b>\$7,102</b>
Funding for Area Plan update – Area Plan was last completed in 2010. Contractor will be hired to revise the Plan. Updates include: changes to HazMat disclosure program and CERS; pesticide drift protocols; consolidation in the Orange Co HazMat Emergency Response JPA; city, county, state and federal response plans and resources; qualitative commodity flow information; and other conforming changes.		
<b>3. Long Beach DHHS, Environmental Health</b>	<b>Area Plan Update</b>	<b>\$7,816</b>
Funding for Area Plan update – unknown when Area Plan was last updated. Revision will be accomplished with agency staff. Updates include: maps and associated tables; phone number and Website address references; addition of Aboveground petroleum Storage Tank program; change references to Cal EMA to Cal OES; addition of CERS requirements; and Unified Program forms.		
<b>4. Fullerton Fire Dept</b>	<b>Area Plan Update</b>	<b>\$11,340</b>
Funding for Area Plan update – Area Plan update was last completed in 2007. Contractor will be hired to revise the Plan. Updates include: changes to HazMat disclosure program and CERS; pesticide drift protocols; consolidation in the Orange Co HazMat Emergency Response JPA; city, county, state and federal response plans and resources; qualitative commodity flow information; and other conforming changes. Only minor amendments since initial development in 1999 require a complete rewrite.		
<b>5. Contra Costa County Health Services, HazMat</b>	<b>2014 CRHMRO HazMat Transportation Workshop</b>	<b>\$25,055</b>
Funding to cover costs of hosting the Coastal Region HazMat Response Organization’s biannual Workshop, including renting the venue; planning, organizing and administering the Workshop; planning and facilitating the culminating functional exercise, and materials. Request includes funding for registration waivers and limited travel expenses for responders from Region II’s most distant counties. <b>6. Marin County Dept of Public Works</b>	<b>Commodity Flow Study</b>	<b>\$38,476</b>
Funding for a county-wide highway commodity flow study to be conducted by a contractor/consultant, with agency staff assistance.		
<b>7. Siskiyou County Public Health</b>	<b>Area Plan Update and Exercise Series</b>	<b>\$21,950</b>
Funding for agency staff to conduct required Area Plan update, and test the Plan through full scale exercise focusing on a rail incident in the Dunsmuir/Cantara Loop area. Area Plan was last updated in 2007. Plan updates include administrative procedures, emergency response procedures, integration of information from HazMat Business Plans in CERS, and pre-incident planning factors.		
<b>8. Nevada County Environmental Health</b>	<b>Area Plan Update and Table-Top Exercise</b>	<b>\$23,784</b>
Funding for agency staff to conduct required Area Plan update, and test the Plan through table-top exercise scenarios – Area Plan was last updated in 2010. Plan updates include references to newly formed Regional HazMat Response Team, administrative procedures, Business Plan and CERS requirements, personnel training and recordkeeping, description of response resources & capabilities, hazard facilities, primary and alternate HazMat transportation routes, and pesticide drift protocols.		
<b>9. San Bernardino County Fire Marshal</b>	<b>Annual NASTTPO Workshop</b>	<b>\$1,904</b>
Funding for registration & travel costs of the LEPC VI Chair to attend the 2014 annual National Association of SARA Title III Program Officials (NASTTPO) Training Workshop and HMEP Grants Assistance Meeting.		
<b>10. 29 Palms Band of Mission Indians</b>	<b>Tribal Emergency Response Plan Update</b>	<b>\$20,000</b>
Funding for the revision of the Tribal Emergency Response Plan to include the Commodity Flow Study (CFS) that was completed in the previous grant cycle. Other objectives of the update include adding measures to address the hazards identified in the CFS; ensuring other related sections are updated and that congruence with other Tribal ordinances, reports, and plans is maintained; ensuring appropriate coordination with local city and county emergency plans; and ensuring the Plan in NIMS-compliant.
