Subject: Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP) Fiscal Year (FY) 2020 Subrecipient Application Update

The FY 2020 HSGP Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) introduced a myriad of changes to how California submits the federal application. Among these changes was the announcement of four new National Priorities and targeted allocations. We are now required to allocate a minimum of twenty percent of the State's grant award to the four National Priorities in order to have the opportunity to obtain the maximum targeted funding allocation. Projects aligning with each of the National Priorities are evaluated on effectiveness measures set forth in the NOFO and are not guaranteed funding.

California is diligently working on robust and competitive projects under these four National Priority areas, but there is no guarantee that we will receive the maximum targeted funding allocation if these projects are either not awarded, or awarded at a lesser amount. In the event there is an overall reduction in funding received by the State, you will be asked to adjust your advance application to meet your final allocations, which will be based on the funding amount awarded to the State.

Cal OES expects to receive its HSGP award in July. At that time, you will receive your FY 2020 HSGP grant allocation, along with instructions for the submission of your final application materials.

The California State Supplemental Guidance covering the FY 2020 HSGP award, along with an announcement of the workshop dates, will be released in the coming months.
