Subject	Response
Amount being requested	The amount being requested should be included in the last box on the Application Form. Disaster Reserve Funds	Disaster Reserve Funds are funds available for use in response to an emergency, whether natural or manmade. Since the ultimate decision will be made based on all facts and circumstances, Applicants may provide additional information about reserve funds. The intent of this request is to ascertain the fiscal capability and/or needs of the jurisdiction to appropriately respond to a PSPS event. Funding for Counties	Counties have received PSPS Allocations and are not eligible to apply for the RFPs for the Cities or Tribes. Please contact your EMPG (Emergency Management Performance Grant) Authorized Agent – they received a Notification of Subrecipient Allocation letter.
The number of hours spent in PSPS	This is the total number of hours spent in a Public Safety Power Shutoff. As PSPS events only began in 2019, it is appropriate to use a year-to-date figure.
Expenditures incurred prior to the award of PSPS allocations	The PSPS Allocation Funds may only be used for Eligible Activities (per page 3 of the RFP) purchased during the performance period of July 1, 2019 through October 31, 2022.

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Allowable Equipment	Please refer to the RFP, under Eligible Activities (page 3). Equipment being purchased under this Program does not need to have an Authorized Equipment List (AEL) number.
Number of Applications allowed	Only one Application per City or Tribe is allowed.
Period of Performance	The period of performance is July 1, 2019 to October 31, 2022. All funds need to be expended and activities completed by October 31, 2022.
