Subject: APPROVAL TO USE THE ANNUAL TRAINING ALLOTMENT FOR ACTIVE SHOOTER SITUATIONS

The California 9-1-1 Emergency Communications Branch (CA 9-1-1 Branch) approves the 9-1-1 County Coordinator's and Public Safety Answering Point's (PSAP's) use of their Annual Training Allotment (ATA) of \$10,000 for State Fiscal Year (FY) 2019-2020 to attend the Active Shooter Situations course to address the current trends in active shooter/active assailant incidents hosted by Pomona Police Department on January 13, 2020. Please see the attached course announcement for additional details. The 9-1-1 County Coordinators and PSAPs are responsible for monitoring and tracking their ATA. Training reimbursement cannot exceed \$10,000 for FY 2019-2020.
