SUBJECT: APPROVAL TO USE THE ANNUAL TRAINING ALLOTMENT FOR ACTIVE SHOOTER SITUATIONS, HOSTED BY PALM SPRINGS POLICE DEPARTMENT, MAY 30, 2020

The California 9-1-1 Emergency Communications Branch (CA 9-1-1 Branch) approves the 9-1-1 County Coordinator's and Public Safety Answering Point's (PSAP's) use of their Annual Training Allotment (ATA) of \$10,000 for State Fiscal Year (FY) 2019-2020 to attend Active Shooter Situations, hosted by Palm Springs Police Department, May 30, 2020. Please see the attached course announcement for additional details. The 9-1-1 County Coordinators and PSAPs are responsible for monitoring and tracking their ATA. Training reimbursement cannot exceed \$10,000 for FY 2019-2020.

The attached State of California Travel Reimbursement Rates reference document provides information regarding the State's reimbursement rates for FY 2019-2020. The second page of the reference document reflects the ATA eligible lodging reimbursement rate for the state of California.
