SUBJECT: APPROVAL TO USE THE ANNUAL TRAINING ALLOTMENT FOR NENA 2020
ANNUAL CONFERENCE & EXPO

The California 9-1-1 Emergency Communications Branch (CA 9-1-1 Branch) approves the 9-1-1 County Coordinator's and Public Safety Answering Point's (PSAP's) use of their Annual Training Allotment (ATA) of \$10,000 for State Fiscal Year (FY) 2019-2020 to attend the National Emergency Number Association's (NENA's) 2020 Annual Conference & Expo in Long Beach, California, June 13-18, 2020. The 9-1-1 County Coordinators and PSAPs are responsible for monitoring and tracking their ATA. Training reimbursement cannot exceed \$10,000 for FY 2019-2020.
