**NG 9-1-1 Alert and Warning System (AWS- Rave):** The NG 9-1-1 AWS is integrated with the Next Generation 9-1-1 Core Services (NGCS) and is available to Local and Tribal Government. The NG 9-1-1 AWS includes the capability to notify internal agency personnel as well as the public and provides a means for the public to opt in to receiving alerts. If authorized to do so, the system can send alerts via the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Integrated Public Alert & Warning System (IPAWS) Wireless Emergency Alert (WEA). The NG 9-1-1 AWS is a service being offered on a voluntary basis and at no cost to the local agencies and Tribal Nations.
