Burn Scars of Concern

Santa Barbara County

- Alisal Fire – High debris flow risk
- Generally the Santa Ynez Mountains

Ventura County

- South Fire – High debris flow risk

San Bernardino/Riverside Counties

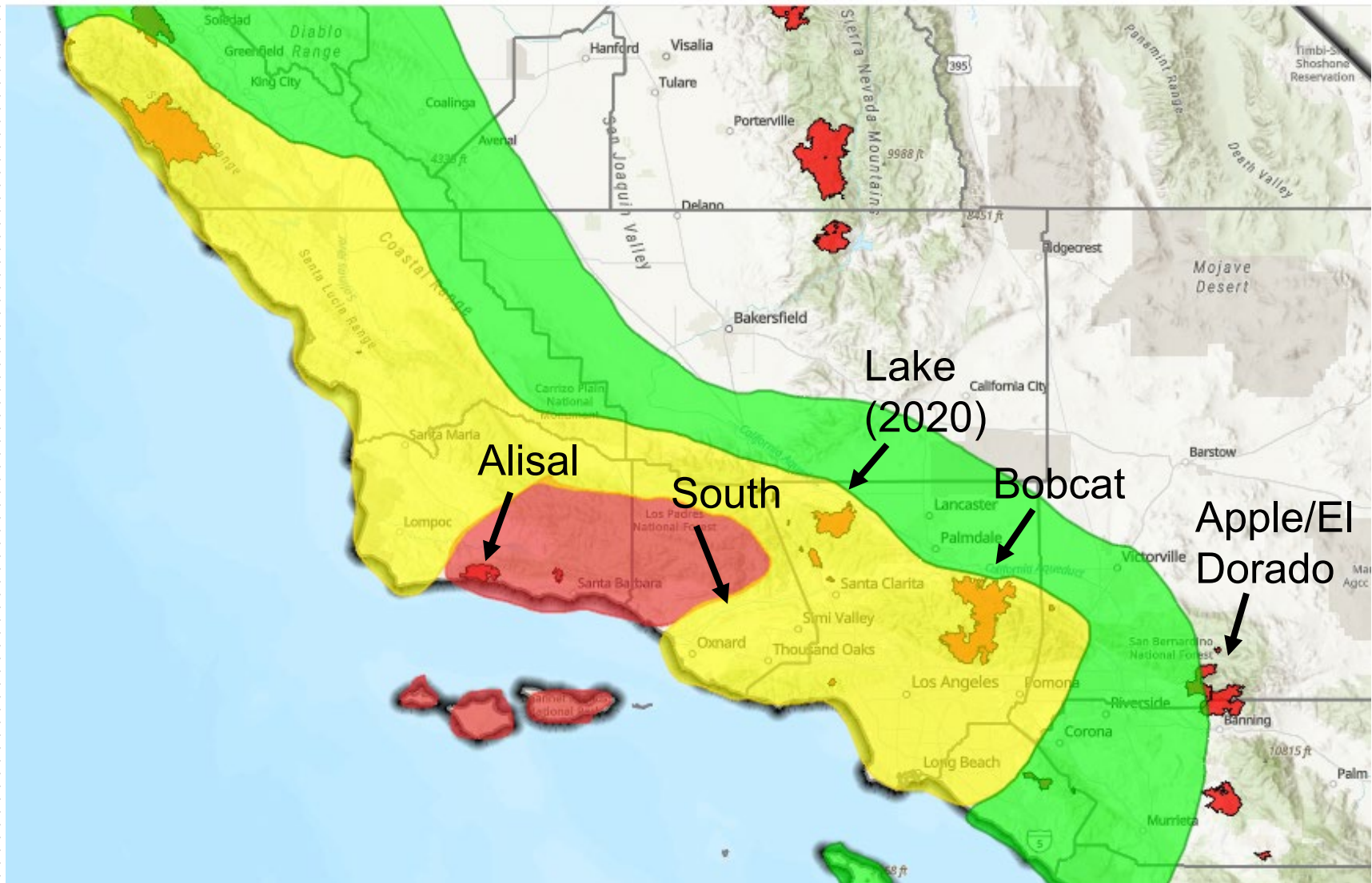
- Apple/El Dorado – Moderate debris flow risk

Los Angeles County

- Bobcat – Moderate
- Lake (2020) - Moderate

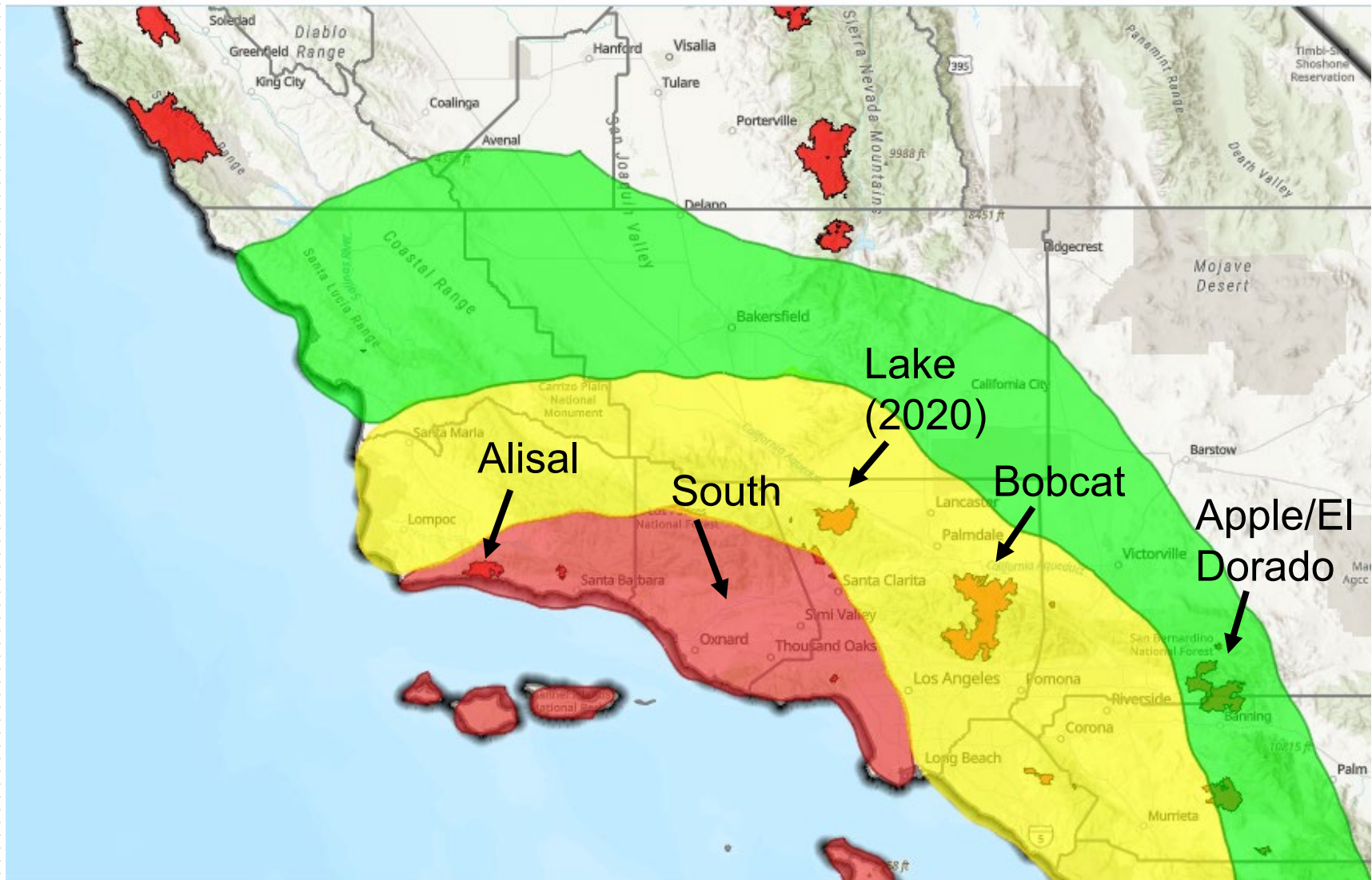
Excessive Rainfall Outlook 12/20/23

- Burned 12/9 – 12/12/2023
- No established debris flow thresholds
- CGS desktop assessment estimates low to moderate debris flow risk based on topographic features, vegetation type, and limited numbers of Values at Risk.
