



How to Change the Language and Add Close Captioning on YouTube



1. Tap or click on the **YouTube** link which will redirect you to the video on the YouTube website.



2. Tap or click on the **“CC”** symbol which initiates closed captioning for the video. A small, **red line** will appear under the “CC” when the closed captioning is on.

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3. Tap or click on
“Settings” which
looks like a wheel.



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
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5. Tap or click on "Auto-translate."




6. A drop down list will appear once you have clicked or tapped "auto-translate." Scroll through the different languages until you find the language you need. Tap or click on the selected language.
