The California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES), Grants Management is soliciting proposals for the FY 2020 EMPG-S Tribal Allocation. The purpose of the FY 2020 EMPG-S Tribal Allocation is to support tribal efforts with preventing, preparing for, and responding to the COVID-19 public health emergency.

For FY 2020, \$102,690 in EMPG-S funds is available for the Tribal Allocation. Applicants may apply for funding up to the total available allocation. Cal OES rates and ranks the proposals competitively; no Applicant is guaranteed funding. After the rating and ranking process is completed, the highest ranking Applicant(s) will be offered funding until all the allocated funding is awarded.
