The California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES), Grants Management is soliciting proposals for the FY 2022 EMPG Tribal Allocation.

For FY 2022, \$218,424 in EMPG funds is available for the Tribal Allocation. The purpose of the EMPG Tribal Allocation is to support tribal efforts to prevent, prepare for, mitigate against, respond to, and recover from emergencies and disasters, whether natural or human-caused.
