Subject: Preparation for the Fiscal Year (FY) 2023 Nonprofit Security Grant Program (NSGP)

The California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES) is encouraging nonprofit organizations to prepare for the release of the FY 2023 Nonprofit Security Grant Program (NSGP), Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) by the Department of Homeland Security/Federal Emergency Management Agency. Upon release of the FY 2023 NSGP NOFO, Cal OES will conduct workshops and/or webinars to provide technical assistance to applicants.

Related application documents should not be submitted to Cal OES at this time.

In preparation for the FY 2023 NSGP application, nonprofit organizations are encouraged to prepare the following information:

- **Unique Entity Identifier (UEI):** Replaces the Dun & Bradstreet (DUNS) number, and is used for identification and validation of unique identity.
 - Applications without a UEI will not be considered.
 - Register at [SAM.gov](https://sam.gov)
- **Vulnerability Assessment (VA):** Identifies the threats, vulnerabilities, and potential consequences related to the specific facility/site. All activities and requested equipment should be directly linked to the VA. It is recommended that the VA be performed by a person with security, emergency services, military, or law enforcement background.
