Tribal Request for Proposal (RFP)

The California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES), Grants Management is soliciting proposals for the FY 2022 HSGP Tribal Allocation.

For FY 2022, \$650,000 in HSGP funds is available for the Tribal Allocation. The purpose of this competitive grant opportunity is to support building or sustaining security enhancement projects that fall within one of the Cal OES HSGP Investment Justifications. Preparedness activities must address high-priority preparedness gaps across one or more of the 32 core capabilities, in addition to requiring a direct nexus to the Prevention, Protection, Mitigation, Response, or Recovery from acts of terrorism.
