Subject: EMPG National Qualification System (NQS) Requirement

The purpose of this memorandum is to address the NQS for EMPG Subrecipients. The NQS provides:

- Foundational guidelines for jurisdictions related to the qualification of personnel within the National Incident Management System;
- Common language and standardized approach for qualifying, certifying, and credentialing incident management and support personnel; and
- Tools for jurisdictions and organizations to share resources.

In FY 2022, Subrecipients were encouraged to begin planning for the NQS implementation. Additional information pertaining to NQS is available on the <u>FEMA website</u>.

As an FY 2023 EMPG post-award requirement, Subrecipients are required to work towards implementation of NQS by developing an Implementation Plan, by adhering to at least one of the following requirements:

- Adopt the FEMA Emergency Management Institute (EMI) 2300 Series Training and the <u>FEMA Position Task Book</u>;
- Adopt Cal OES's Credentialing Program; or
- Implement their own program using the <u>FEMA Implementation Plan</u> <u>Template</u>.

The FY 2023 EMPG Quarterly Reports will be updated to capture how the NQS requirement is being met.
