Subject: Fiscal Year (FY) 2025 EMPG Allocations

On July 28, 2025, the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) released the FY 2025 EMPG Notice of Funding Opportunity. California was allocated \$24,392,241, a decrease of \$73,551 from the FY 2024 EMPG allocation of \$24,465,792.

The EMPG is a critical grant program that enables state, local, and tribal governments to prepare for all hazards. These funds are allocated annually to all counties and tribal nations to support these very important efforts. Historically, the annual EMPG funding is allocated to Cal OES for statewide initiatives and Operational Area objectives.

The enclosed chart delineates the FY 2025 EMPG allocations to Operational Areas, with a comparison to the FY 2024 allocations. Cal OES is preparing the FY 2025 EMPG application that will be submitted to FEMA no later than August 11, 2025. The allocations are being shared so that subrecipients can begin planning.

Cal OES recognizes subrecipients have many questions and concerns regarding the FY 2025 EMPG NOFO. Cal OES has updated its Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) page to address common questions received about the new terms and conditions contained in the NOFO. Cal OES is working diligently to not only submit the FY 2025 EMPG application to FEMA, but also to obtain clarification regarding the new terms and conditions.
