

# Physical and Digital Infrastructure Security Grant Program Frequently Asked Questions

Question	Answer
When is the deadline to apply for the Physical and Digital Infrastructure Security Grant Programs?	The deadline to apply for the Physical and Digital Infrastructure Security Grant Programs is 5:00 p.m. March 2, 2023. Your proposal is considered submitted based on the timestamp of the e-mail containing your attached proposal.
What is the original source of these funds?	The Physical and Digital Infrastructure Security Grant Program is funded by the State General Fund.
What is the fund code, fund year, and program code?	The fund code is PDIS and the fund year is 2022.  The program code for the Physical and Digital Infrastructure Security Grant Program for Health Care Facilities is DF22, and the fund code for the Physical and Digital Infrastructure Security Grant Program for Health Care Practitioners is DP22.
Can someone be listed on the Signature Authorization (Cal OES form 2-103) who is not listed on the Contact Information (Cal OES form 2-102)? Who is authorized to sign?	The Project Director and Financial Officer must be listed on both the Contact Information (Cal OES form 2-102) as well as the Signature Authorization (Cal OES form 2-103). However, other authorized signers may be included on the Signature Authorization form that are not listed on the Contact Information form.
How do you list multiple locations re: project site on the Face Sheet (Cal OES form 2-101)? Can multiple rows be created?	Per the RFP, Applicants may not alter the formatting of any forms. Please list details regarding project sites in the Grant Subaward Programmatic and Budget Narrative form.
Can an Applicant receive more than \$500,000 if a proposal is submitted on behalf of multiple facilities within their organization?	Per the RFP, Applicants may apply for up to \$500,000 per facility, for the 54-month Grant Subaward performance period. However, please keep in mind that each proposal is reviewed and scored in its entirety. The proposal is scored based on the thoroughness and detail provided in the proposal and scored according to the rating sheet in the RPF, Part V, pages 18 – 20. Either all facilities under one proposal will be funded or none. If the facilities have unique differences or needs, we recommend submitting a separate proposal for each facility.
