Fortra FileCatalyst Workflow Vulnerability

Critical Vulnerability

The California Cybersecurity Integration Center (Cal-CSIC) has become aware of a critical vulnerability with a released exploit proof of concept (POC) known as CVE-2024-5276.^{1,2} The vulnerability affects all versions of FileCatalyst Workflow from 5.1.6 Build 135 and earlier.³ Exploitation of the structured query language (SQL) injection vulnerability may allow a remote unauthenticated attacker to create rogue admin users and manipulate data on the application database.⁴

The Cal-CSIC recommends immediately upgrading to FileCatalyst Workflow version 5.1.6 build 139 or newer.

Organization Description
