

Jodi Lopez, Division Chief LEMA Program (916) 845-8307 "In May 2022, Governor Gavin Newsom, in collaboration with the California State Sheriff's Association (CSSA), purposed the creation of the Law Enforcement Mutual Aid (LEMA) Assistance Fund to reimburse local law enforcement agencies that respond to disasters and emergencies. Upon approval by the California State Legislature, \$25 Million was appropriated on an annual basis. On July 1, 2022, the LEMA Assistance Fund took effect, and the CAL OES Law Enforcement Branch was tasked with developing and managing the LEMA Fund." Don O'Keefe

CRITERIA

- Provided for more than a 12hour period.
- Requested to preposition resources (doesn't require 12hour period), undeclared events or before declarations are known.
- Request is related to a state or federally declared state of an emergency.
- Requested for a multijurisdictional event.
- jurisalctional event.
- Major law enforcement action requiring extended or specialized LEMA.
- For a mass casualty incident or extended mass causality operation.
- Technology support or specialized resources to support LEMA response.

ELIGIBLE EXPENSES

- Responding officer Overtime
- Backfill for responding officer
- Lodging
- Per Diem
- Mileage- to & from incident.
- Fuel
- Extraordinary Equipment
- * Overtime, backfill, and fuel will be reimbursed at the actual costs.
- Lodging, per diem, and mileage will be reimbursed at the State Rate.
