All remarks shall be addressed to the State 9-1-1 Advisory Board Members as a body. Speakers should be brief and limit comments to the subject of discussion.

Board Members. If prior delivery is not possible, it is requested that a minimum fifteen (15) copies be submitted to the State 9-1-1 Advisory Board liaison prior to the start of the scheduled meeting. The materials will be distributed to the State 9-1-1 Advisory Board Members.
