**Subject: ANNUAL TRAINING ALLOTMENT AUTHORIZATION**

The California 9-1-1 Emergency Communications Branch (CA 9-1-1 Branch) approves the 9-1-1 County Coordinator's and Public Safety Answering Point's (PSAPs) use of their Annual Training Allotment (ATA) for State Fiscal Year (FY) 2022-2023 to attend "What If It Were Family?" held on December 19, 2022.
