**Subject: ANNUAL TRAINING ALLOTMENT AUTHORIZATION**

The California 9-1-1 Emergency Communications Branch (CA 9-1-1 Branch) approves the 9-1-1 County Coordinator's and Public Safety Answering Point's (PSAP's) use of their Annual Training Allotment (ATA) for State Fiscal Year (FY) 2022-2023 to attend a Next Gen 9-1-1: Demonstration for New Cloud Based Call Handling Equipment held on February 13, 2023, at 6640 Beach Blvd, Buena Park, CA 90620. Please refer to the CA 9-1-1 Branch Operations Manual, Chapter III - Funding for the updated allotment per PSAP. Please see the attached course announcement for additional details. The 9-1-1 County Coordinators and PSAP's are responsible for monitoring and tracking their ATA. Training reimbursement cannot exceed the allotment in Chapter III for FY 2022-2023.
