The California 9-1-1 Emergency Communications Branch (CA 9-1-1 Branch) approves the 9-1-1 County Coordinator's and Public Safety Answering Point's (PSAP's) use of their Annual Training Allotment (ATA) for State Fiscal Year (FY) 2022-2023 to attend the Southern California APCO Chapter Meeting on July 20, 2023 at Ventura County Fire Department, 165 Durley Ave., Camarillo, CA 93101.
