**Subject: ANNUAL TRAINING ALLOTMENT AUTHORIZATION**

The California 9-1-1 Emergency Communications Branch (CA 9-1-1 Branch) approves the 9-1-1 County Coordinator's and Public Safety Answering Point's (PSAP's) use of their Annual Training Allotment (ATA) for State Fiscal Year (FY) 2025-2026 to attend "Innovative Supervision on the Dispatch Floor" on March 18, 2026, at Citrus Heights Police Department, 6360 Fountain Square Drive, Citrus Heights, CA 95621.
