Subject: ANNUAL TRAINING ALLOTMENT AUTHORIZATION

The California 9-1-1 Emergency Communications Branch (CA 9-1-1 Branch) approves the 9-1-1 County Coordinator's and Public Safety Answering Point's (PSAP's) use of their Annual Training Allotment (ATA) for State Fiscal Year (FY) 2025-2026 to attend the 2026 California Real Time Summit on March 23-24, 2026, at Orange County Sheriff's Real Time Operations Center, 1382 Bell Avenue, Tustin, CA 92780. Please refer to the CA 9-1-1 Branch Operations Manual, Chapter III-Funding for the updated allotment per PSAP. Please see the attached course announcement for additional details. The 9-1-1 County Coordinators and PSAP's are responsible for monitoring and tracking their ATA. Training reimbursement cannot exceed the allotment in Chapter III for FY 2025-2026.
