**Subject: ANNUAL TRAINING ALLOTMENT AUTHORIZATION**

The California 9-1-1 Emergency Communications Branch (CA 9-1-1 Branch) approves the 9-1-1 County Coordinator's and Public Safety Answering Point's (PSAP's) use of their Annual Training Allotment (ATA) for State Fiscal Year (FY) 2026-2027 to attend "Rise: Women in Policing" on September 8-11, 2026, at Town and Country Resort, 500 Hotel Circle North, San Diego, CA 92108. Please refer to the CA 9-1-1 Branch Operations Manual, Chapter III- Funding for the updated allotment per PSAP. Please see the attached course announcement for additional details. The 9-1-1 County Coordinators and PSAP's are responsible for monitoring and tracking their ATA. Training reimbursement cannot exceed the allotment in Chapter III for FY 2026-2027.
