**Subject: ANNUAL TRAINING ALLOTMENT AUTHORIZATION**

The California 9-1-1 Emergency Communications Branch (CA 9-1-1 Branch) approves the 9-1-1 County Coordinator's and Public Safety Answering Point's (PSAP's) use of their Annual Training Allotment (ATA) of \$10,000 for State Fiscal Year (FY) 2021-2022 to attend a Kim Turner Live Online Training, De-Escalation for Dispatchers, February 20, 2022. Please see the attached course announcement for additional details. The 9-1-1 County Coordinators and PSAP's are responsible for monitoring and tracking their ATA. Training reimbursement cannot exceed \$10,000 for FY 2021-2022.
