Subject: ANNUAL TRAINING ALLOTMENT AUTHORIZATION

The California 9-1-1 Emergency Communications Branch (CA 9-1-1 Branch) approves the 9-1-1 County Coordinator's and Public Safety Answering Point's (PSAP's) use of their Annual Training Allotment (ATA) for State Fiscal Year (FY) 2025-2026 to attend Kim Turner's Dispatcher's Role in Critical Incidents online course on August 29th.
