Pursuant to Section 3.3 of Agreement No. 6150-2020 between the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES) and NGA 911, LLC (NGA), please be advised that Cal OES is terminating the contract. This letter serves as notice that the contract will terminate at 11:59 pm on April 10, 2026, which is thirty (30) calendar days from the date of this letter.

In November of 2024, Cal OES advised NGA that its CPE must undergo lab validation before it could be installed at any PSAP in California due to recurring issues with the CPE at Desert Hot Springs Police Department and Wasco Police Department. On August 1, 2025, Cal OES sent a problem notification letter to NGA requesting a corrective action plan to address the problems with the CPE. On September 3, 2025, Cal OES accepted NGA's corrective action plan, which included a representation that the CPE would undergo lab validation by September 26, 2025. Unfortunately, NGA did not meet that deadline. To date, NGA's CPE still has not passed end-to-end lab validation.

Open orders for NGA's CPE are also being cancelled. Currently, there are twelve (12) open orders. Pursuant to section 4.3 of Agreement 6150-2020, the CPE was required to be completely installed and ready for acceptance testing within ninety (90) calendar days after the TD-288 "Commitment to Fund" was issued by Cal OES. Another Purchase Approval Package would need to be processed and a new TD-288 issued before any CPE could be installed. The current CPE contract expires on July 7, 2026, which is less than four (4) months away. As a result, Cal OES is
