

Yesenia Sanchez, of Livermore, has been appointed to the State 9-1-1 Advisory Board. Sanchez has been the Sheriff-Coroner at the Alameda County Sheriff's Office since 2023. She has held multiple other positions at the Alameda County Sheriff's Office since 1997, including Division Commander from 2020 to 2022, Captain from 2015 to 2020, Lieutenant from 2013 to 2015, Sergeant from 2009 to

2013, Deputy Sheriff from 2001 to 2009, and Sheriff's Technician from 1997 to 2001.
