CDA-2017-12: December 2017 California Wildfires California Disaster Assistance Act Funding for the December 2017 California Wildfires

CALIFORNIA GOVERNOR’S OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES

On December 7, 2017, a Governor’s Proclamation was issued to secure funding to help Los Angeles, San Diego, Santa Barbara, and Ventura Counties respond to and recover from the December 2017 California Wildfires which burned over 300,000 acres, caused evacuations for thousands of residents, damaged critical infrastructure, and forced closure of major highways and local roads. This fact sheet contains information regarding the available assistance and California Disaster Assistance Act (CDA) application information.

Important Disaster Information

The incident period is December 4, 2017, through TBD.

The December 2017 California Wildfires incident (CDA-2017-12) makes available CDA funding for eligible costs in Los Angeles, San Diego, Santa Barbara, and Ventura Counties.

Applicants Eligible for Assistance

The following local government entities are eligible for disaster assistance under CDA:

- Cities
- Counties
- Special Districts
- School Districts
- Community College Districts
- Certain Private Non-profit Organizations
