Community Update

San Diego County

- San Diego County SME provided response to EHP RFI #2 and still under review by FEMA
- 9 home assessments completed under the new version of the app and were marked final through QA
- 1 SOW is in final stages and 1 SOW undergoing QA
- RFQ for contractors was published for hardening received for 4 responses. SD already has a list of qualified d-space contractors.

Shasta County Fire Safe Council

- SME is finalizing response to FEMA for RFI #2-submitting to FEMA this week
- 7 home assessments completed under the new version of the app and were marked final through QA
- 2 SOW developed by the community ready for final QA
- Finalizing Contractor RFQ for publishing



Community Update Cont.

Lake County/North Coast Opportunities

- Awarded by FEMA in March
- 2 assessments QA'd need minor update to finalize
- Continued to onboarding and training new staff
- Received virtual CAL FIRE training on D-space and Home Hardening in last two weeks
- In-person home assessment training 5/25/23
- RFQ for contractors closes soon

El Dorado and Tuolumne Counties

Pending FEMA approval for phase project



Outreach to Potential New Demonstration Communities

Siskiyou County/Shasta Valley Resource Conservation District

- Submitted a subapplication to Cal OES and it is in the award process
- Total Project Cost: \$3,598,000
- 100% state funds
- D-space (Zone 0, 1 & 2) in approximately 100 parcels



Budget Update

SB 85 Split into 2 funding years

- Encumbered \$8 M
 - 10% match for SD, Shasta, Lake, and 5% admin
 - Must be liquidated by 6/30/24
 - Advances may be necessary
- Encumbering \$13.9M
 - 15% match for SD and Shasta
 - Match for Tuolumne and El Dorado
 - 100% project cost for Siskiyou
 - Must be liquidated by 6/30/25
 - Advances may be necessary if BCP is not approved to extend liquidation



Budget Update Cont.

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Budget Update Cont.

AB 179 - Ch 249 SFY 22/23 allocation of \$13 M

- \$12,350,000 for program
- \$650,000 for administration
- Must be encumber by 6/30/2027



CAL FIRE Update

- Recently completed the classroom portion of our CWMP hybrid Defensible Space/Home Ignition Zone training for Lake County and CWMP Staff.
- 2) Completed the CWMP Zone 0 minimum quality standard.
- 3) Working on updating the Home Hardening Assessment App with Zone 0 criteria.
- 4) Reviewed National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) research paper, "Outdoor Structure Separation Experiments (NOSSE) with Wind".
- 5) Initiated a Wildland-Urban Interface Fire Safety Building Standards Compliance Training Working Group
