- ATF Webinar: A systematic approach to evaluate and prescribe post-fire triggering rainfall thresholds.
- October 26, 2023, 9:30 to 11:00 am, Pacific time
- The California Geological Survey (CGS), in partnership with other State and Federal agencies, conducts post-fire assessments to identify areas susceptible to post-fire floods and debris flows, and prescribe triggering rainfall thresholds keyed to the anticipated runoff response
- The triggering rainfall thresholds are incorporated into specific post-fire emergency response plans that define where and when to deploy resources and, in some cases, initiate evacuation orders.
- The effects of fire and their influence on the type and magnitude of runoff response are often greatest within the first year following fire.
- In this presentation, we introduce a multi-step process that CGS has developed to systematically assess and prescribe post-fire triggering rainfall thresholds in the first few years following fire.
