

# Grant Related Resources December 2024

#### Rural Utility Service Technical Assistance and Training Grant Program

- Application deadline December 31, 2024
- Qualified private non-profit organizations will receive grant funds to assist communities with water or wastewater systems through free technical assistance and/or training provided by the grant recipients.

#### Stream Gage Improvement Program

- Application deadline December 31, 2024
- Upgrade, reactivate, or install new surface water monitoring stations that share stream flow data to help inform water management decisions.

#### National Fish Passage Program Base Funding Fiscal Year 2024

- Application deadline December 31, 2024
- Provides assistance to remove in-stream barriers while restoring aquatic organism passage and connectivity.

# <u>California Advanced Services Fund: Broadband Public Housing Account – January 2025 Cycle</u>

- Application deadline January 1, 2025
- Provides grants and loans to finance projects to build broadband networks offering free broadband service for residents of low-income communities.

#### State Historic Rehabilitation Tax Credit

- Application opens January 6, 2025
- The State of California offers tax credits for the rehabilitation of eligible historic residential and commercial properties. Property must be eligible for or listed in the California and/or National Registers.

#### 2025 Tribal Transportation Program Safety Fund

- Application deadline January 15, 2025
- Eligible projects are consistent with a transportation safety plan and correct or improve a hazardous road location or feature, or address a highway safety problem, including infrastructure improvements that reduce the risk of serious injury crashes.



# CAL FIRE Forest Health - California Grants Portal

- Application deadline January 15, 2025
- Funds active restoration and reforestation activities for more resilient and sustained forests while also mitigating climate change, protecting communities from fire risk, strengthening rural economies and improving California's water & air.

#### Department of Toxic Substances Control Technical Assistance Grant (TAG)

- Application deadline January 15, 2025
- Provides funds to eligible communities to hire independent Technical Advisors (TAs) to effectively communicate technical information to communities to become more involved and informed about Response Actions (cleanup sites).

#### Sustainable Transportation Planning Grants | Caltrans

- Application deadline January 22, 2025
- Funding to support and implement Regional Transportation Plan Sustainable Communities Strategies/Alternative Planning Strategies.

#### FY25 State Fire Capacity Wildfire Hazard Mitigation

- Application deadline January 22, 2025
- Restore and Maintain Landscapes: Landscapes across all jurisdictions are resilient to fire-related disturbances, in accordance with management objectives.
- Create Fire Adapted Communities: Human populations and infrastructure can withstand a wildfire without loss of life or property.
- Additionally, SFC priorities reflect the national USFS priorities of improving the condition of forests, and grasslands, promoting shared stewardship by increasing partnerships and volunteerism, and by being good neighbors and providing excellent customer service.

# State Digital Equity Capacity Grant Program: Native Entities | BroadbandUSA

- Application deadline February 7, 2025
- Funds initiatives that help Native communities to fully access and take advantage of the digital world, by aiding economic development, preserving traditional practices, and facilitating inter/intra-government coordination.



#### GRANTS | Latinos in Heritage Conservation | USA

- Application deadline February 15, 2025
- Funds Latinx heritage and historic preservation projects. This initiative is designed to empower grassroots, Latinx-focused nonprofit organizations and community groups.

#### Community Wildfire Defense Grant 2024 (FY25)

- Application deadline February 28, 2025
- The purpose of the Community Wildfire Defense Grant is to assist at-risk local communities and Indian Tribes with planning and mitigating against the risk created by wildfire.

#### Rural Business Development Grant Program

- Application deadline February 28, 2025
- The purpose of the program is to promote economic development and job creation projects through the awarding of grant funds to eligible entities.

# <u>Single Family Housing Repair Loans & Grants in Presidentially Declared Disasters</u> <u>Pilot | Rural Development (usda.gov)</u>

- Due to Lack of Funding, USDA Pauses Pilot Program to Repair Homes Damaged by Presidentially Declared Disasters.
- This is effective as of June 7, USDA intends to renew the pilot if funding becomes available again.
- This pause for the pilot program will not affect applications from those who are 62 and older who remain eligible for regularly appropriated funding under USDA's Single Family Housing Repair Loans and Grants Program.
- Community Facilities Program Disaster Repair Grants
- Open until July 18, 2025, which is the conclusion of the pilot program
- Grants will be provided to eligible applicants to repair eligible essential community facilities damaged by Presidentially Declared Disasters that occurred on or after July 18, 2022

#### Behavioral Health Bridge Housing (BHBH) Program

Application deadline June 30, 2027



 Providing over a billion dollars in funding to county behavioral health agencies and Tribal entities to operate bridge housing settings to address the immediate housing needs of people experiencing homelessness who have serious behavioral health conditions, including serious mental illness (SMI) and/or substance use disorder (SUD).

#### Manufactured Housing Opportunity and Revitalization Program (MORE)

- The MORE program helps fund a variety of activities intended to keep Mobile home Parks a safe and affordable homeownership option.
- MORE funds can be used for the acquisition, conversion to resident organization ownership, rehabilitation, reconstruction, and replacement of mobile home parks, as well the remediation of health and safety items of both parks and individual mobile homes.

#### Proposition 13 – Water Recycling – Planning Grant - California Grants Portal

- Application Deadline: On-going
- Period of Performance: June 30, 2027
- Eligible projects include recycled water treatment; recycled water storage, distribution, and pumping; groundwater recharge; and indirect portable reuse.

#### <u>Proposition 68 – Water Recycling - California Grants Portal</u>

- Application Deadline: On-going
- Period of Performance: June 30, 2027
- Provide technical and financial assistance to local agencies
- Construction of water recycling projects
- Promotes the beneficial use of treated municipal wastewater in order to augment fresh water supplies in California.
