Mobile Disaster Recovery Centers (MDRC): offer in-person support to individuals and small business owners. Recovery specialists from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) are available to assist survivors.

Mobile Registration Intake Center (MRIC): The sole function of MRICs is to register survivors for FEMA. MRICs move around regularly and may be in an area for a short period of time to reach survivors who need **registration help only**.
