



Under the Emergency Services Act (Government Code § 8628) the Governor, through Cal OES, is authorized to direct state agencies to utilize state personnel, equipment, and facilities to prevent or alleviate damage due to emergencies. Additionally, Government Code § 8570(j) allows the Governor, through Cal OES, to take preparatory steps, including the partial or full mobilization of emergency organizations in advance of an actual emergency. The Emergency Services Act also allows agencies that are mission tasked through this process to expend any money which has been appropriated to it. When mission tasked, agencies will deliver services as directed under this authority, regardless of whether additional funding is provided. The information provided below will be reported to the Department of Finance. Any agencies reporting costs that are not absorbable in existing budgets should be prepared to discuss with the Department of Finance, which makes the final determination regarding whether additional funding can be provided.
