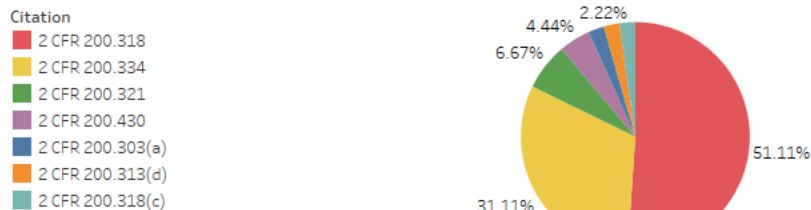
What are advisories?

A compliance review advisory is a document that Cal OES uses to provide guidance, updates, and information related to subrecipients of FEMA grant programs. Advisories are intended to help subrecipients understand the requirements and processes for receiving and expending FEMA funding. Advisories help subrecipients understand documenting projects appropriately, account for disaster costs accurately, and minimize the risk of losing funding from lack of source documentation, financial misstatements from overly generalized accounting, overly generalized personnel timekeeping, and lack of up-to-date policies and procedures.

Key Areas of Focus:

Vetting of Contractors/Vendors: Verifying and documenting the status of intended vendors/contracts using the correct source, the system for award management (sam.gov).
Documentation: Keeping detailed records of the justification and history for procurements. Receipts and or Invoices for disaster-related expenses.
Cost Allowability: Ensuring that costs are necessary, reasonable, and allowable under federally awarded project requirements.
