15. What is the estimated number of displaced households and where they are staying?

16. Are there sufficient housing and rental resources to meet the needs of the displaced? If no, where are the nearest available resources?

17. Describe local and VOAD activities, and agency resources available.

18. Is there a significant need for counseling services?



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19. Describe impact on special populations (i.e., access and functional needs, people with language barriers, seniors, and children).
