Eligible Reimbursement Expenses

Eligible Costs for Providing Agencies:

- Responding Officer Overtime
- Backfill for Responding Officers
- Vehicle (consistent with FEMA rates when applicable)
- Extraordinary Equipment (Case by Case i.e. ISU vehicles, Rapid DNA, etc.)

Eligible Costs for Requesting Agencies:

- Expenses (in support of and for Providing Agencies) related to food, fuel, and lodging for approved LEMA Fund Incidents and approved LEMA Fund SAR's.
- Expenses related to logistical needs to support the deployment of the Providing Agencies. (i.e.; porta-potties, copy machines, etc.)
